



# Nursery Rhymes Lesson Plans

## Nursery Rhyme:

<p><b>Objective-</b> TSW review the nursery rhyme The Itsy Bitsy Spider.</p> <p><b>Materials-</b> Jack Hartman's The Itsy Bitsy Spider.</p> <p><b>Procedure-</b> Student's will listen to Jack Hartman's Itsy Bitsy Spider using hand motions that go along with song.</p> <p><b>Evaluation-</b> Assess using student's responses.</p>	<p><b>Objective-</b> TSW create their own spider webs.</p> <p><b>Materials-</b> construction paper, markers, black paint or black ink pad.</p> <p><b>Procedure-</b> In one corner of a plain sheet of construction paper, draw a spider web with a marker. Use a black washable stamp pad or black paint and have students put a thumbprint on the paper. Have students draw on the legs(8), eyes, etc. and connect the spider to the rest of the web.</p> <p><b>Evaluation-</b> Assess using student's final product</p>	<p><b>Objective-</b> TSW create their own suns. Student will identify the color yellow.</p> <p><b>Materials-</b> paper plate, yellow paint, wiggle eyes, markers</p> <p><b>Procedure-</b> Cut triangle shapes out around the edge of a paper plate to form the sun's rays. Paint yellow and let dry. Glue on wiggle eyes (or draw them) and draw nose and mouth with black marker. Sing Yellow song.</p> <p><b>Evaluation-</b> Assess using student's final product.</p>
<p><b>Objective-</b> TSW will create a spider web.</p> <p><b>Materials-</b> Yarn, glue, construction paper.</p> <p><b>Procedure-</b> Cut several pieces of yarn in various lengths. Use white glue (like Elmer's Glue) and make a spider web pattern on a piece of construction paper. Let child glue yarn onto the paper to form a spider web.</p>	<p><b>Objective-</b> TSW identify insects and how a spider is an insect.</p> <p><b>Materials-</b> pictures of spiders, <b>The Very Busy Spider</b>.</p> <p><b>Procedure-</b> Have students tell you what they know about spiders, talk about how a spider is an insect, show the class pictures of spiders, read the story <b>The Very Busy Spider</b> .</p>	<p><b>Objective-</b> TSW use songs to learn about the sun.</p> <p><b>Materials-</b> Oh Mr Sun song</p> <p><b>Procedure-</b> Play the song Oh Mr. Sun, discuss the sun, what color it is, where it is, and how it dries up the rain.</p> <p><b>Evaluation-</b> Assess using student's responses.</p>
