



Nursery Rhymes Lesson Plans

Nursery Rhyme: Twinkle Twinkle Little Star

<p>Objective- TSW use illustrations to preview a story or poem.</p> <p>Materials- "Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star" nursery rhyme, Frog Street "Colors" CD & Dr. Jean's Rhyming CD</p> <p>Procedure-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Recite "Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star." 2. Have students recite nursery rhyme and discuss rhyming words. 3. Have students name objects that are yellow and color star. 4. Sing color song, "Yellow." <p>Evaluation- Coloring and ability to follow directions during nursery rhyme activity</p>	<p>Objective- TSW make a star using triangles.</p> <p>Materials- "Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star" nursery rhyme, yellow paper, scissors, crayons, glue</p> <p>Procedure-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Recite "Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star." 2. TSW recite nursery rhyme and discuss rhyming words. 3. TSW draw 2 triangles on yellow paper and cut them out 4. TSW glue the triangles to make a star and glue on any color background paper. 5. TSW sound out "star" using the secret story for "ar" <p>Evaluation- teacher observation, finished product and following directions</p>	<p>Objective- TSW make a star snack.</p> <p>Materials- "Twinkle Twinkle Little Star" nursery rhyme, pretzel sticks, chocolate frosting, graham crackers.</p> <p>Procedure-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Recite "Twinkle Twinkle Little Star". 2. TSW recite nursery rhyme and discuss rhyming words. 3. TSW use one finger to spread frosting on square graham cracker. 4. TSW make a triangle out of 3 pretzel sticks, then turn the cracker and make another triangle with 3 pretzel sticks forming a star. 5. Enjoy snack! <p>Evaluation teacher observation, finished product and following directions</p>
<p>Objective- TSW make a star frame using popsicle sticks.</p> <p>Materials- popsicle sticks, glue, glitter, camera</p> <p>Procedure-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. TSW make 2 triangles using popsicle sticks (6 per student) Allow to dry. 2. TSW glue them to make a star. 3. TSW paint glue on one side of the star and dip in glitter. 4. TSW take a picture of each student to put in the star. <p>Evaluation- teacher observation, finished product and following directions</p>	<p>Objective- TSW make a diamond using 2 triangles.</p> <p>Materials- construction paper, crayons, scissors, glue</p> <p>Procedure-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. TSW draw 2 triangles. 2. TSW glue the triangles to a background sheet to make a diamond. 3. TSW ask how is a star like a diamond in the sky?
